THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RYERSON

By-Law # 1 - 23

Being a by-law to appoint an Integrity Commissioner and repeal By-law # 55-18

WHEREAS Section 223.3 of the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, as amended, authorizes municipalities to appoint an Integrity Commissioner who is responsible for acting in an independent manner to apply the Code of Conduct of Council and local boards and other such duties as may be assigned to them by the Municipality;

AND WHEREAS our present Integrity Commissioner has advised the Township of Ryerson that he will be retiring as soon as we appoint a replacement;

AND WHEREAS the Township of Armour issued a Request for Proposal on behalf of ten (10) Almaguin Municipalities seeking the services of an Integrity Commissioner and received proposals from:

- Expertise for Municipalities
- > John DaRe, Barrister & Solicitor
- ADR Chambers Inc.
- Weaver Simmons LLP

AND WHEREAS the ten (10) Almaguin Municipal Clerks appointed an Evaluation Committee to evaluate the proposals; with the proposal from ADR Chamber Inc. receiving the highest combined score based on the evaluation criteria as detailed in the Request for Proposal;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Ryerson enacts as follows:

- 1. That the Request for Proposal for an Integrity Commissioner be awarded to ADR Chambers Inc., represented by Michael Maynard.
- 2. That ADR Chambers Inc., represented by Michael Maynard, is hereby appointed the Integrity Commissioner for the Township of Ryerson.
- 3. That this By-law, Request for Proposal and the successful proposal from ADR Chambers Inc. shall form an agreement to purchase services between the Township of Armour and ADR Chambers Inc.
- 4. That this By-law repeals By-law # 55-18.
- 5. That this By-law shall come into force and effect upon its passing.
