DISCUSSIONS

Marjorie Robinson presented an overview of Capital Asset Management to Council.

The legal requirements for an Asset Management Plan in Ontario Regulation 588/17 were outlined.

The concepts involved in the Capital Asset Management process were defined and discussed. It will involve Council making decisions balancing levels of service, long run life cycle costs and risks. Council received a copy of the Strategic Asset Management Policy adopted earlier in 2019. A history of asset management planning in the Township was also highlighted.

Brayden Robinson and Marjorie Robinson have drafted a template, updating the current Asset Management Plan and a copy of the draft will be e-mailed to Council. The deadline to approve the new Plan is July 2021.

The roles and responsibilities of Council and Staff were noted, stressing the importance of all being engaged in the process of asset management.
