Location: Approximately 116 km of road – both sides of the roads within the Township of Ryerson, as outlined on the map attached.

Lowest or any quote not necessarily accepted.

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ROADSIDE MOWING

To mow approximately 116 km of Township Roads (both sides of the roads, approximately 232 km of mowing); providing a tractor and mower with the capabilities of producing a 5' cut capable of following the shoulder contour; and providing a qualified operator.

Roads to be mowed as directed by the Public Works Supervisor or designate. A map as a general guideline is attached.

Quotes **must** be submitted on the Township form, including the map attached showing the Township roads to be mowed.

A list specifying equipment to be used **must** be attached.

Proper warning devices must be used, according to the Ontario Traffic Manual Book 7 dated January 2014. Equipment must conform to the regulations of the Highway Traffic Act.

In order to avoid any misunderstanding as to the nature of the work to be performed herein, the Contractor, by executing this contract, unequivocally acknowledges that he/she is the constructor within the meaning of the Occupational Health and Safety Act and the Contractor undertakes to carry out the duties and responsibilities of a constructor with respect to the work.

It is specifically drawn to the attention of the bidder that the Occupational Health and Safety Act provides in addition to other matters that:

A constructor shall ensure, on a project undertaken by the constructor that

- a) the measures and procedures prescribed in this Act and the regulations are carried out on the project;
- b) every employer and every worker performing work on the project complies with this Act and the regulations; and
- c) the health and safety of the workers on the project is protected.

When an unsafe act is being committed during the completion of this tender, the Public Works Supervisor, or his designate, will notify the on-site foreman. If the act is not remedied, the Ministry of Labour will be informed. The successful bidder shall provide confirmation of the Firm's Comprehensive General Liability and Property Damage Insurance Coverage, by means of a Certificate of Insurance for the works, within ten (10) calendar days of

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receiving the Acceptance Notice. Liability limits shall be at least \$5,000,000 per occurrence and include the municipality as an additional insured, with a minimum thirty (30) days' notice of cancellation.

The successful bidder shall also deliver proof of Workplace Safety and Insurance Board coverage (if applicable) within ten (10) calendar days of receiving the Acceptance Notice.

Documents to be filed with Township Clerk prior to commencement of work.

Work to be completed between July 2, 2024 and August 9, 2024.

If the work is not complete by the above date, or by an amended date allowed by an approved extension of time, then the Contractor agrees to pay the municipality a sum of \$100.00 per calendar day for each day's delay in finishing the work, as liquidated damages. Delays due to weather will be taken into consideration by the municipality.
